## FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL: WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 6TH

Our first day of school is <u>Wednesday, September 6th.</u> This is a full-day session of school. Student drop-off will take place starting at 8:45 a.m. The instructional day will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. when children should be in their homerooms. At arrival, staff members will be stationed at various locations within the building, bus lanes, and alongside the drop-off lane. <u>In the interest of safety, parents will not be permitted to enter the building during this drop-off time.</u> In the event you have school supplies that need to be dropped off, or questions answered by members of our faculty, please make arrangements to come to the school at times that do not coincide with student arrival.







## ARRIVAL / DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

#### ARRIVAL:

- -Doors open at 8:45 AM. Student arrival is between 8:45 AM and 9:00 AM. Children arriving after 9:00 AM will need to be escorted to the main office by a parent or guardian, and will be marked "tardy" in Genesis.
- -If your child will be driven to school in a personal vehicle, it is encouraged that you enter our property by turning right off of Conover Road. Stay to your far right to enter the student drop-off lane. Students are to exit the vehicle, curb-side, where a faculty member is present. Parents must assist children in exiting the vehicle quickly and safely to keep a steady flow of traffic in the drop-off lane. Please assist children with organizing belongings.
- -Bus riders will be greeted by staff members each day. In the early days of school, students will be dismissed by grade level and will be directed to the doors that are labeled for their assigned grade level. Staff members will be stationed in the bus lane and school hallways to direct children to classrooms.



- -Preschool students will be dismissed from their class at 3:05. Teachers will escort children to foyer for dismissal.
- -Parents of preschool children should arrive by 3:05 and park in our school lot. Parents will create a line at the front of the school. Photo identification will need to be presented in order for your child to be released to a parent or caregiver.

#### K-2 DISMISSAL:

- -If you are picking up your child from school, be sure to fill out the "Daily Pickup Release Form" in the Genesis Parent Portal by <u>noon</u> on the date of pick-up.
- -Parents picking up their child from school should arrive to our property by 3:15. Parents will wait in the K-2 dismissal line. Photo identification will need to be presented in order for your child to be released to a parent or caregiver.
- -If you are picking up your child from school everyday, call the school office to verify that you have added your child's name to the Permanent Pick-Up List on the Parent Portal.
- -The end of our instructional day for students in K-2nd grade is 3:15 PM. We will begin the dismissal process at 3:16, and intend to release the buses from our school property by 3:30 PM.

## PREPARING FOR A SMOOTH START:

Your child may express both excitement and even a tiny bit of anxiety about the upcoming transition to a new school and/or new grade level. In order to better prepare your child (and yourself) for a vibrant and colorful school experience, we offer the following tips:

Let your child know the daily schedule. Tell him/her what time school begins and ends each day.

It is important that your child knows all aspects of daily routines including who will be waiting at the bus stop at the end of the day; what types of lunch/snacks are permitted to purchase; or who your child should speak to in the event of a problem.

Determine your child's feelings about the new school year (both the excitement and the concerns) about starting school.

Most small children appreciate having opportunities to hear about your own childhood experiences. This is a great opportunity to look at old school photos of yourself at the same age as your child. Share with them your hopes as well as fears to start the conversation.

Students new to the school should visit before school officially starts.

If your child is a <u>new</u> 1st or 2nd grader, or a kindergarten student registered after our June Kindergarten Preview, please join us for our New Student Orientation on August 31st at 9:00 a.m. Preschool students will have an orientation in their designated class room on September 1st at 10:00 a.m.

Point out the positive aspects of starting school. Fun, new friendships and learning adventures await!

Many of our students are especially excited about the "Specials" or Related Arts classes that we offer at CRPS. Your child may be eager to hear about the Art, Music, Spanish, Library, Innovation Lab, Physical Education, Health, and Science Enrichment Lab experiences that lie ahead.

Let your child know that all kids (and grown-ups, too) are nervous about the first day of school.

There are many sources of children's literature that allow children to realize that a range of emotions are normal when starting a new school year. At the Conover Road Primary School, we find that the children especially enjoy *First Day Jitters* by Julie Danneberg, *The Kissing Hand* by Audrey Penn, *Wemberly Worried* by Keven Henkes, *The Berenstain Bears Go Back to School* by Stan and Jan Berenstain, and *Pete the Cat: Rocking in My School Shoes* by James Dean and Eric Litwin.
